#### Video Equipment Must Haves

**CAMERA** 

<u>DSLR</u> - \$300+ Steep Learning Curve - Need attachments to set audio level - Many lens options

<u>Go Pro</u> - \$150 - \$500 Moderate Learning Curve - Easy microphone connection - Versatile

<u>Video Camcorder</u> - \$200 + - Built-in microphone - Option to connect 2 mics - Fixed lens - Moderate learning curve <u>Phone</u> - Easy to use - Microphone connection - Minimal learning curve

### **MICROPHONE**

<u>Wired Lavalier</u> clip-on mic - \$20 - \$50 - Wire may get in the way

<u>Wireless</u> - \$50+ - Easy to use 
Rechargeable - Many include

Lavalier clip-on

Shotgun/Stick (wired or wireless)

\$20 - \$200 - Good for interviews -Recording large groups, events, natural sound

Need special cabling to connect to Apple & Android phone - Check mic for phone capability

#### **TRIPOD**

<u>All-in-One/Phone</u> - \$10 - \$25 - Legs & head attached - Portable - Easy to use - Lightweight - Consider camera weight & use

<u>Studio</u> - \$75 - \$200 - Durable - Many features - Fluid head allows smooth moves - heavy yet durable
